This table shows a vote by the GOP-led House Rules Committee on Sept. 2, 2025, that defeated a Democratic amendment to advance the Epstein Files Transparency Act (HR 4405) to the House floor for an up or down vote. The transparency bill on that date was buried in the GOP-led House Judiciary Committee. The House and Senate passed the bill in late November and President Trump signed it into law on Nov. 19, 2025.
