GOP-Led Panel Kills Bid to Subpoena Epstein Banking Records

This table shows a vote by a subcommittee of the House Financial Services Committee on Sept. 9, 2025, that killed a Democratic bid to subpoena the Treasury Department for release of records on at least \$1.5 billion in banking transactions by Jeffrey Epstein's criminal ring. The subpoena targeted legally required "suspicious activity" reports that JP Morgan Chase, Bank of America, Deutsche Bank and Bank of New York submitted over many years to the department.
