This table shows an 8–2 vote on July 23, 2025, by the Federal Law Enforcement Subcommittee of the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform to subpoena the Department of Justice and FBI for public release of The Epstein Files. This was the second-ever congressional vote on Epstein and his decades-old global sex-trafficking ring. Rep. Summer Lee, D-Pa., introduced the motion.
