



Congressional Votes on The Epstein Files

Reveal of Any Ex-Presidents' or Trump Communications in The Epstein Files

On a tie vote of 5-5, the Federal Law Enforcement Subcommittee on July 23, 2025, failed to pass a motion by Rep. Robert Garcia, D-Calif., requiring public release from The Epstein Files of any communications that President Trump or former U.S. presidents had with Jeffrey Epstein. The subcommittee is a unit of the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform. This was the first-ever congressional vote on Epstein and his global sex-trafficking ring.
